### Side by Side Book One – Chapter 6

The words below are taken from Side by Side, Book One, Chapter 6. For each word below please write in what the word means and then a sentence using the word.

**A Play:** the stage representation of an action or story.  
*Sentence:* Mark performed as the king in the school play.

**Angry:** filled with anger: having a strong feeling of being upset or annoyed.  
*Sentence:* Our teacher was very angry because nobody did their homework.

**Argument:** **1** an angry disagreement. **2** statement(s) for against something. **3** a discussion in which people express different opinions about something.  
*Sentence:* My parents had a big argument about which cellphone to buy.

**Aunt:** the sister of your father or mother or the wife of your uncle.  
*Sentence:* He has three aunts.

**Bake:** to cook (food) in an oven using dry heat.  
*Sentence:* We like to bake cookies after school.

**Band:** a group of musicians organized to play music together.  
*Sentence:* Have you heard the new band?

**Barking:** a short loud cry (often for attention) made by dogs.  
*Sentence:* We could not sleep because the neighbors dog kept barking.

**Bicycle:** a 2-wheeled vehicle that a person rides by pushing on foot pedals.  
*Sentence:* There are many bicycles in China.

**Brother:** a boy or man who has one or both of the same parents as you.  
*Sentence:* My brother lives in a different city.

**Cake:** a sweet baked food made from a mixture of flour, sugar, and other ingredients such as eggs and butter.  
*Sentence:* She blew out the candles on her birthday cake.

**Calculator:** a small electronic device used for adding, subtracting, etc.  
*Sentence:* I use a calculator to check my math homework.

**Children:** young people usually younger than thirteen.  
*Sentence:* There are many children at the primary school this year.

**Clock:** a device other than a watch for displaying or measuring time.  
*Sentence:* We need a new clock for the classroom wall.

**Corner:** the point or area where two lines, edges, or sides of something meet. the place where two streets or roads meet.  
*Sentence:* You can find a bank on the corner.

**Cousin:** a child of your uncle or aunt.

*Sentence:* She has twelve cousins.

**Cry:** to produce tears from your eyes often while making loud sounds because of pain, sorrow, or other strong emotions.

*Sentence:* Some people cry more easily than others.

**Dancing:** to move your body in a way that goes with the rhythm and style of music that is being played.

*Sentence:* She loves to practice ballroom dancing.

**Daughter:** a female offspring especially of human parents.

*Sentence:* Her daughter is the top student at the school.

**Diagram:** a drawing that explains or shows the parts of something.

*Sentence:* The attached diagram shows how to replace the battery in your phone.

**Drums:** a percussion instrument consisting of a hollow shell or cylinder with a drumhead stretched over one or both ends that is beaten with the hands, stick or brush.

*Sentence:* The children at the local school practice the drums every morning.

**Father:** a male parent.

*Sentence:* My father comes home from work at 8pm most nights.

**Fireplace:** a specially built place in a room where a fire can be built.

*Sentence:* We like to sit by the fireplace during cold and snowy days.

**Gown:** a long, formal dress that a woman wears especially during a special event.

*Sentence:* She wore a beautiful white wedding gown.

**Grandchildren:** a child of your son or daughter. your children's children.

*Sentence:* Grandchildren are often spoiled by their grandparents.

**Granddaughter:** the daughter of your son or daughter.

*Sentence:* Her granddaughter will come to visit this summer.

**Grandfather:** the father of your father or mother.

*Sentence:* My grandfather helps me with my math homework.

**Grandmother:** the mother of your father or mother.

*Sentence:* My grandmother likes to bake cakes for us.

**Grandparents:** the parents of your mother or father.

*Sentence:* Our grandparents live with us during the summer.

**Grandson:** a son of your son or daughter.

*Sentence:* Her grandson is very good at sports.

**Husband:** a married man: the man someone is married to.

*Sentence:* Jane's husband works at the bank.

**Mother:** **1** a female parent. **2** a woman in authority.

*Sentence:* My mother is a housewife.

**Nephew:** a son of your brother or sister.

*Sentence:* We do not see our nephew very often.

**Niece:** a daughter of your brother or sister.

*Sentence:* Our niece will visit us this weekend.

**Parents:** a mother and father.

*Sentence:* My parents will come to school today to meet my teachers.

**Photograph:** a picture made by a camera.

*Sentence:* Many people take photographs with their cellphones now.

**Piano:** a large musical instrument with a keyboard that is played by pressing black and white keys to produce sound.

*Sentence:* Many young musicians first learn how to play the piano.

**Reading:** a book, article, etc., that is being read or that is intended to be read.

*Sentence:* My English class is reading "A Tale of Two Cities".

**Singing:** to use your voice to make musical sounds in the form of a song or tune.

*Sentence:* You can hear our neighbors singing in the shower every night.

**Sister:** a girl or woman who has one or both of the same parents as you.

*Sentence:* My sister is a teacher.

**Skateboarding:** to ride a skateboard, a short board that is on wheels and that a person stands on to move along a surface or to perform tricks.

*Sentence:* The kids practice their skateboarding at the park every weekend.

**Sofa:** a long and comfortable piece of furniture people can sit or lie down on.

*Sentence:* We all sit on the sofa when we watch the television.

**Son:** a male child.

*Sentence:* He is the son of a lawyer and a doctor.

**Teenager:** a person between 13 and 19 years old.

*Sentence:* It is not easy being a teenager.

**Uncle:** the brother of your father or mother or the husband of your aunt.

*Sentence:* My uncle is a dentist.

**Vacuuming:** to clean using a device that creates a vacuum (absence of air).

*Sentence:* Sally is vacuuming the living room.

**Wedding:** a ceremony at which two people are married to each other.

*Sentence:* Some girls plan their wedding many years in advance.

**Wife:** a married woman: the woman someone is married to.

*Sentence:* He met his wife while they were both students.

**Writing:** the activity or work of writing books, poems, stories, etc. the way that you use written words to express your ideas or opinions.

*Sentence:* Writing is a very good way to learn a new language.
